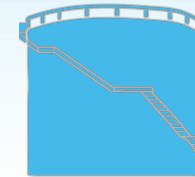

DURING GCWA'S ANNUAL CHLORINE MAINTENANCE

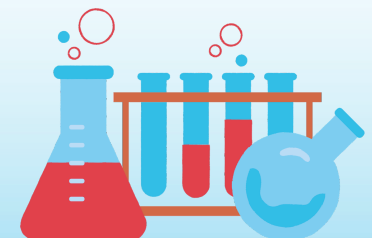
AMMONIA IS REMOVED FROM THE DISINFECTION PROCESS. WITHOUT AMMONIA, THE CHLORINE IN THE WATER MAY BE MORE NOTICEABLE, BUT THE AMOUNT IS CONSISTENT WITH LEVELS YEAR-ROUND.



FLUSHING FROM THE FIRE HYDRANT IS AN IMPORTANT PART OF MAINTAINING THE WATER SYSTEM, AND GCWA CUSTOMERS MAY FLUSH TO MOVE WATER THROUGH PIPES MORE QUICKLY.



ROUTINE TESTING IS CONDUCTED THROUGHOUT THE CHLORINE MAINTENANCE PROCESS TO ENSURE WATER QUALITY STANDARDS ARE MET.
